





### Human Environment Interaction Adaptation & Modification (5 min)

Adaptation is the process of changing a behavioral trait in order to survive in an environment.

### Examples of behavioral traits include:

- Food
- Clothing
- Shelter




### Human Environment Interaction Adaptation & Modification

**Modification** is the changing of the physical environment to enhance its safety, security, utility, or accessibility

### Examples of modification:

- ☆ mining
- transportation infrastructure (highways/freeways)
- ☆ dams
- ☆ irrigation systems


