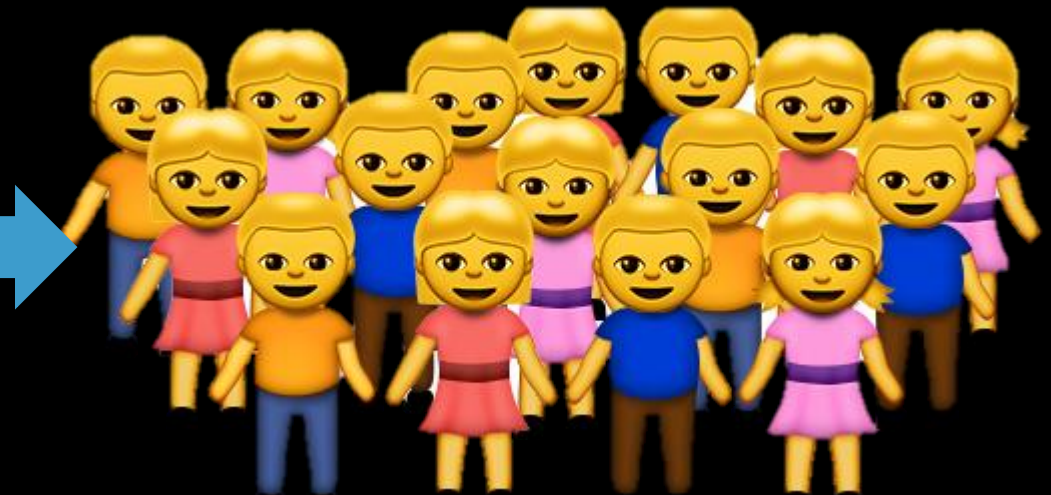

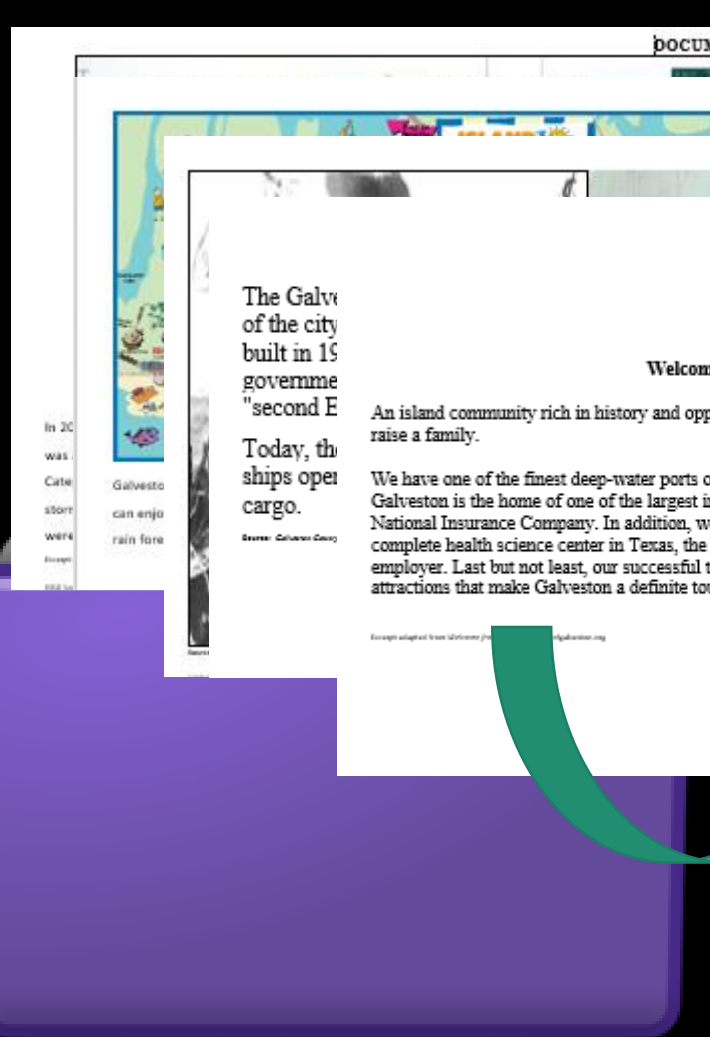

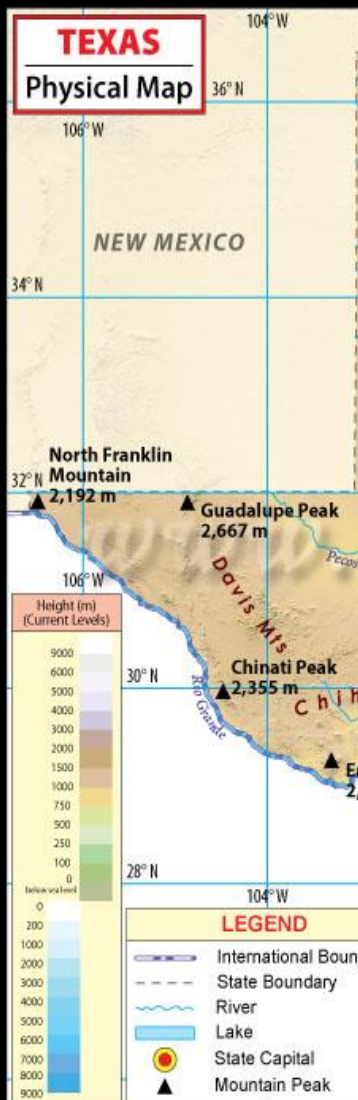


Intermittent Maps

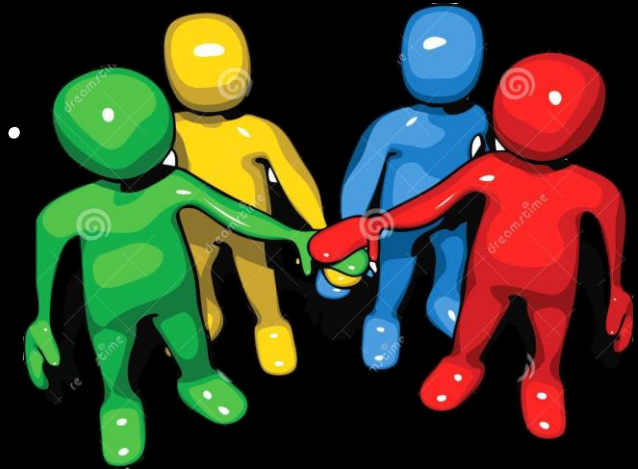
